1MATTERS ARISING

Minutes for the previous meeting were accepted.

Arthur's old county youth club still to be assigned a competition: it can be awarded to the U15 boys and girls club that has the least combined points at the end of next season's XC league.

2 TREASURER'S REPORT

XC League analysis (see table below) shows we made £18,440 in total, with a profit of almost £8,000. Very worthwhile financially; also positive feedback on the varied locations / courses. Preentry worked well, and guaranteed income even if athletes later decided to drop out of a fixture.

John will endeavour to ascertain the bank details of clubs hosting a fixture so they can receive a £100 fee by way of thanks from the GAAA.

Virgin have started charging us to use the bank account. This is due to the amount of transactions. Rachel will enquire if other banks offer free accounts.

We now have the paperwork to sort out the bank mandate.

Most of the counties clubs' affiliation fees have been obtained – however there are a few clubs outstanding (Angels, Cirencester AC, Cotswold All Runners, Tetbury Dolphins, Tewkesbury RC). These will be chased.

3 ROAD RACE SERIES

The Blaisdon 10k has been included in the series, replacing the Staverton 10. Whilst this reduced the proportion of longer-distance events in the series, it is the best available option and allows us to maintain a 12-event series.

The series table has been updated following the Berkeley 20. There was a very small delay while information was gathered on runners who were not in the software database.

The next event in the series is the Berkeley 10k on Coronation Day – May 8th. This is also a county championship race, as are the Bourton 1 mile and half marathon, and the Gloucester August 5k.

Appreciate it would be a long journey south for some – however, seeing as how Bath clubs provide many runners for our league, it would be good to have a different club put on a fixture (and our county league or indeed championships do not have to be held in our own county).

We moved away from holding a fixture in January due to clashes with the SW championships. However, there remains the possibility of Cotswold Farm Park the first weekend of January if all else fails.

5 TRACK & FIELD CHAMPIONSHIPS

The person who normally helps with the fixation of disabled athletes (Carolyn) is away on the date: Arthur will look into how this can be sorted.

Elliot and Andrew K. are devising the timetable and the heat compositions. Each heat should have a varied spread of athletes from different clubs and of different abilities.

Clubs are reminded there is no entry qualification for the county championships – so please encourage athletes to enter!

We confirm there is unlikely to be be a 10,000m due to lack of interest.

Entries close 5 days beforehand: April 24th.

6 OTHER MATTERS

We clarified a query resulting from a recent race where there was not a certain veteran category (LV35). Apparently, due to equality, the veteran categories will start at 35 for both men and women.

Perhaps in view of the poor turnout for this meeting, in future it might be better to stay clear of school holidays!
